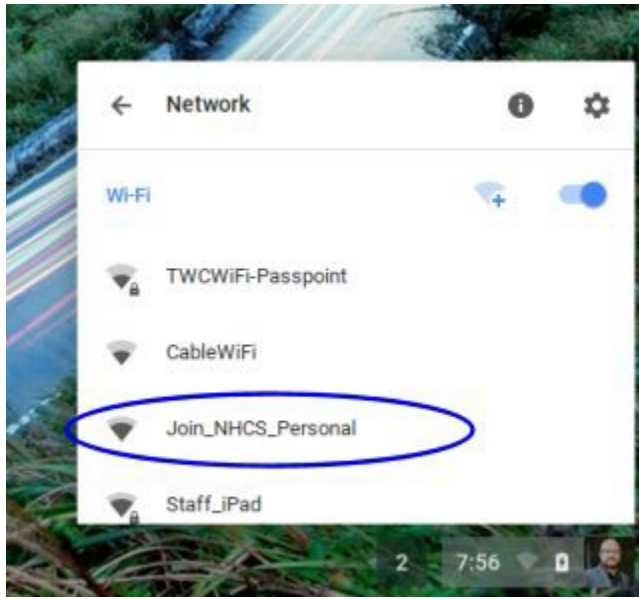


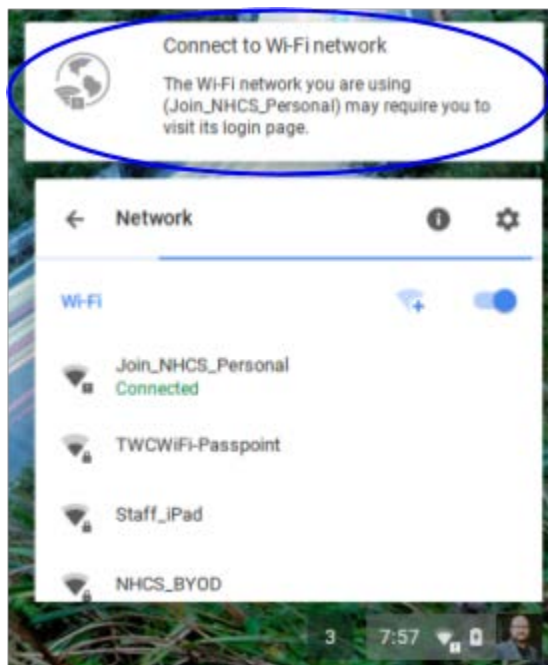
NHCS_Personal Chromebook Instructions.

While you are logged into your Chromebook select your wifi indicator in the bottom right corner and select **Join_NHCS_Personal**.



Once connected you will see a dialogue box appear that prompts you to visit a login page. Click that and the portal page will open.



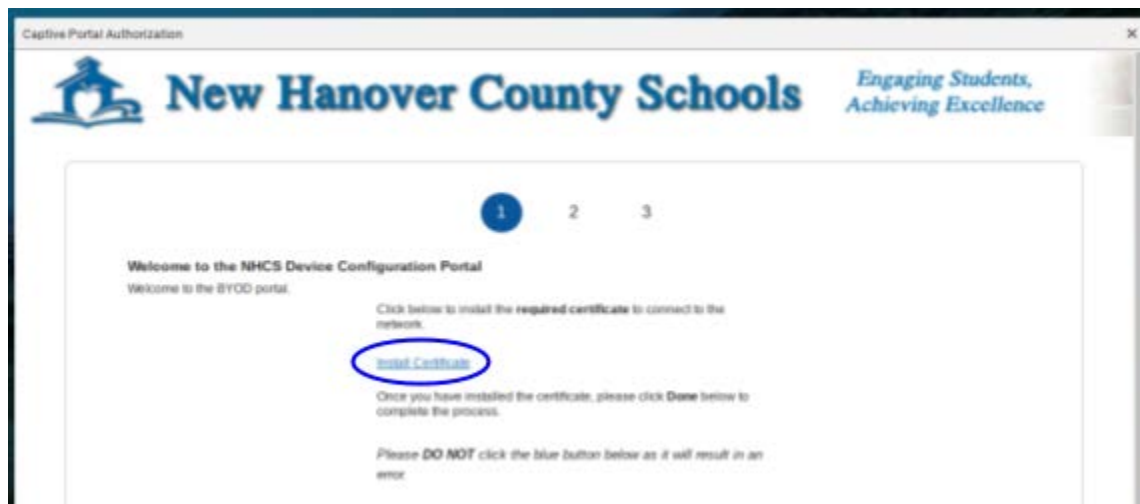
Please use the same username and password you use to log into a NHCS computer.

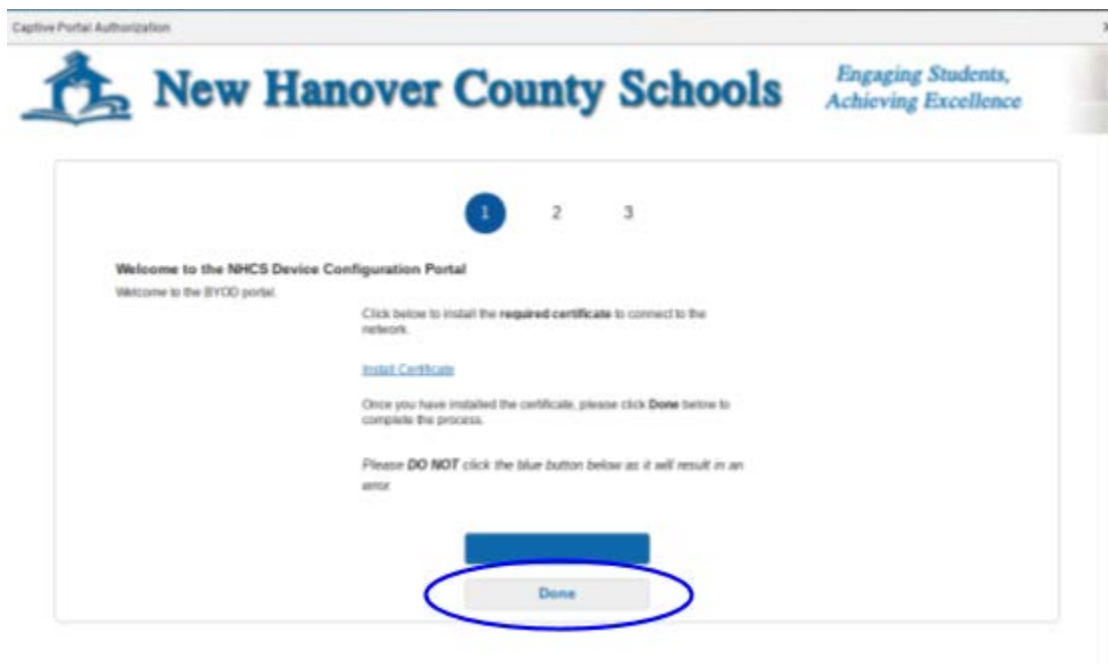

Do NOT click the blue button.



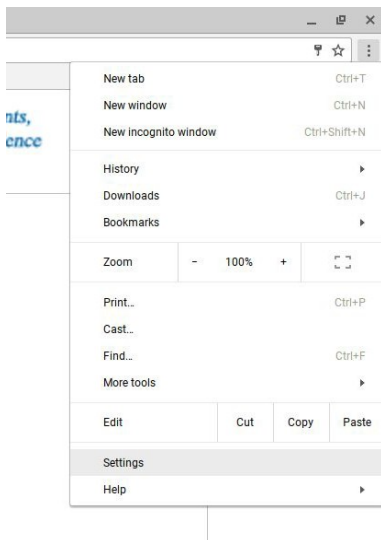
At the next screen select **Finish**.



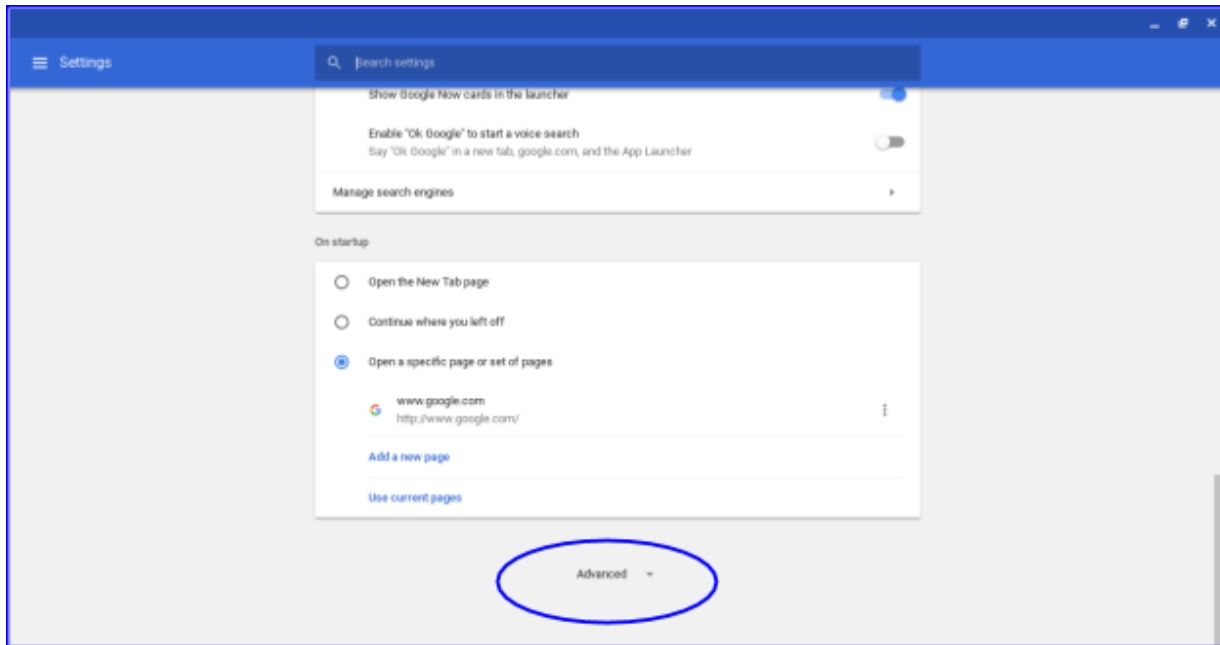

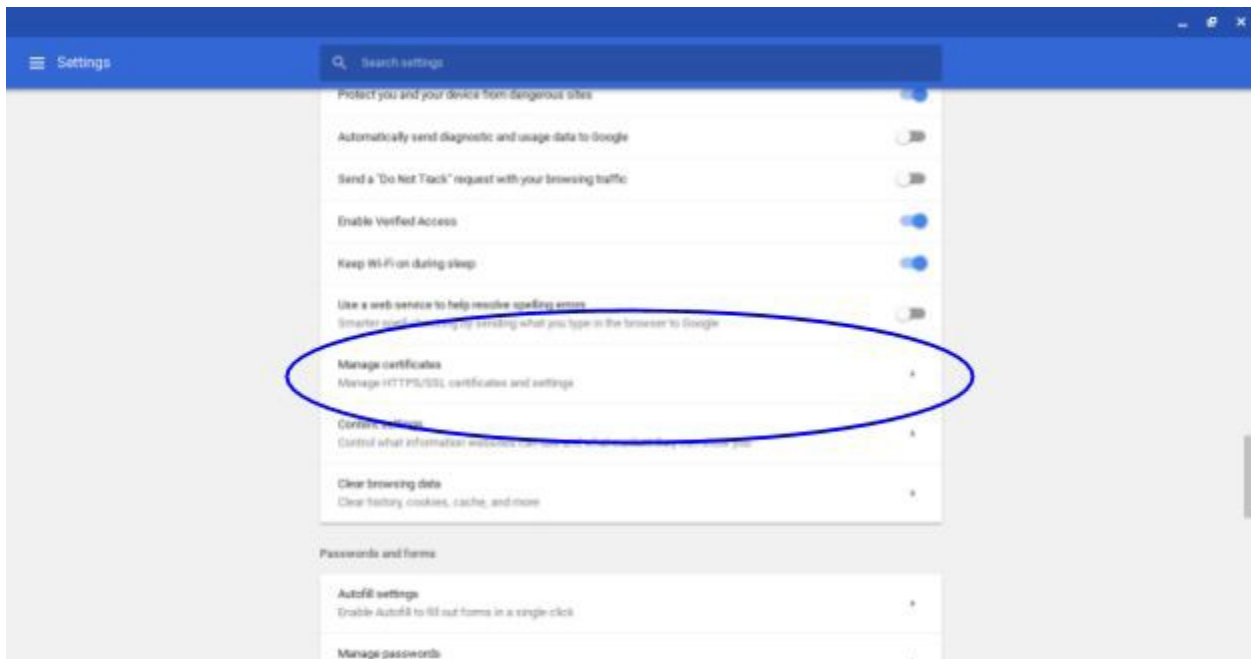
Open Chrome and select the 3 dots in the top right corner of your Chrome browser and then select **Settings**.



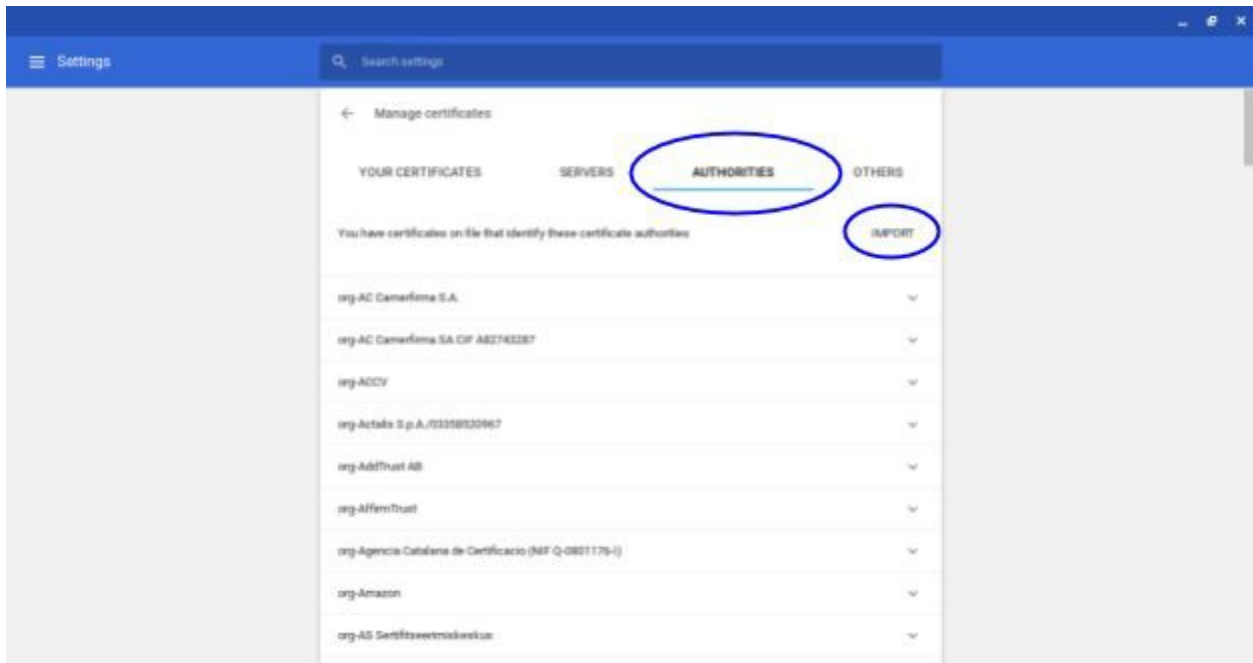
When the settings window opens scroll to the bottom and select **Advanced**.



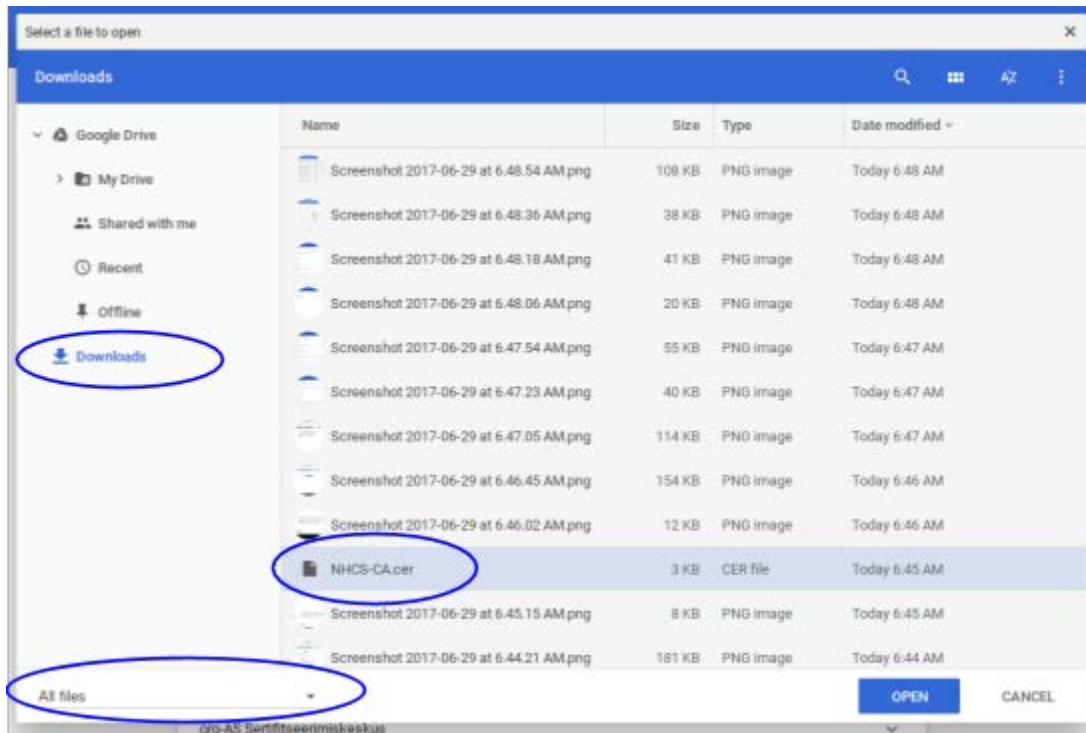
Select **Manage Certificates**



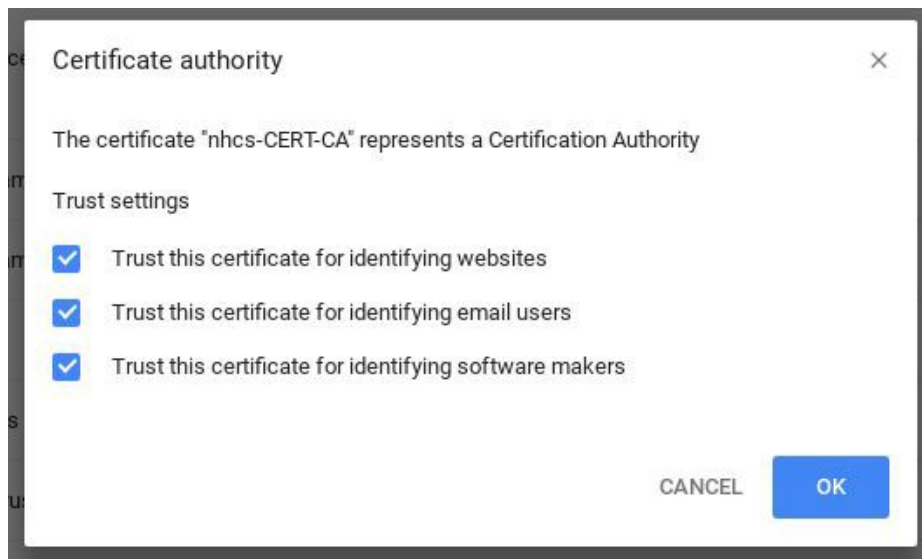
Select the **Authorities** tab and then **Import**



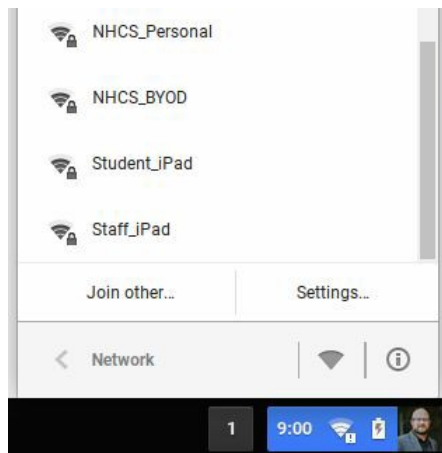
A new window will open, select the **Downloads** folder on the left, then select **All Files**. Select the **NHCS-CA.cer** file and then click **Open**


