

WELCOME TO LANEY HIGH SCHOOL

The following is useful information for enrolling a student:

1. Pursuant to North Carolina General Statute 115C-366, a student shall be assigned to a school by the Board of Education in accordance with the student's domicile.
2. A domicile can be proved by one of the following:
 - a. Current Lease Agreement – signed and dated by both parties
 - b. Current Renters Insurance Policy
 - c. Current Mortgage Statement of Deed
 - d. Current Homeowners Insurance Policy
 - e. Current Real Estate Property Tax Bill
3. A student's domicile may be changed only in the event the parent/legal guardian/legal custodian has abandoned the former domicile with no intention of returning to it; and has established actual domicile in another location, and evidenced an intention to remain in the new location permanently or indefinitely. A minor may not select, acquire, or change his/her domicile to a domicile other than that of the minor's parent/legal guardian/legal custodian. A student may have only one domicile at a time.
4. Updating Address: If a student's domicile changes during any school year, it must be updated. The parent/legal guardian must notify the school of the correct address by presenting Laney with one of the above documents. Failure to do so may result in the inability by NHCS to process the student's application.
5. Definitions:
 - a. Assigned School – A school proximate to the student's domicile (or residence, for a student residing in a group home, foster home or pre-adoptive home or a homeless student), located in a student's transportation zone, to which a student is guaranteed admission.
 - b. Legal Custodian – A person or agency that has been awarded legal custody of a student by a court.
 - c. Legal Guardian – A person who has been appointed guardian of a student by a court.
 - d. Open Choice Application – An application to a school where the parent must provide transportation. (Laney is an open choice school not an open enrollment school)
