

YOU can help Murray earn money with your TRASH...

Murray has both new and established programs in place that make considerable money for our school. There's a new collection bin in the office that's ready for your money-making submissions of all the items listed below. You can also deposit any items at the school store when it's open during lunch. The Box Tops program is our main money maker so you can deposit them in the envelopes located in each home base as well as the office and school store. Here's what we collect:

Empty INKJET & LASER printer cartridges. These have considerable value--up to \$5 per cartridge. Just put them in an old bag to seal in any leakage and drop off.

Digital cell phones. Get rid of them here; they can earn us up to \$5 each! Accessories and chargers aren't needed or wanted. Keep the battery and card in them as if is safe. (They CANNOT be activated again in your name; they'd have to know your password--mother's maiden name, etc.--to do so.)

Box Tops for Education program: These small coupons are on so many different kinds of food packages and earn us 10 cents each. Don't cut off the expiration date or they're void! We're only given two times per school year to submit these so make sure you get them in regularly or they might expire before our next allowed submission date. Log on to <http://www.boxtopsforeducation.com> for more info. *It is quite possible to earn \$1,000 or more per year on these tiny coupons so please submit!*

Tyson Project A+ program: They pay more than double what Box Tops do—24 cents each. Look for them on Tyson frozen chicken boxes, bags, and lunchmeats. The entire box flap or zip-off top piece is what is needed for submittal. Log on to <http://www.tyson.com/projectaplus/> for more info.

SHOP & EARN ADDITIONAL \$\$\$ FOR MURRAY:

Harris Teeter "Together in Education" program: Murray earns money on all Harris Teeter brand purchases. The program runs August-May of each year. *** Shoppers must RE-LINK their VIC card at the beginning of each school year, beginning Aug. 1st.*** You can do this online (<http://www.harristeeter.com>), at the store, at our PTA meetings, or call one of the representatives listed at the bottom of this sheet and she'll be happy to do it for you. You can link your VIC card to up to five schools and Harris Teeter will evenly distribute funds.

Food Lion's Shop & Share program: A percentage of your total purchase goes to our school. ***Just like at Harris Teeter, remember to RE-LINK your card the beginning of each school year, in the early Fall.*** You can do this online (<http://www.foodlion.com>), or let us do it for you. You may only designate one organization per quarter but it can be changed from quarter to quarter...please consider Murray!

Target's Take Charge of Education program: This program is linked to their credit cards so, if you're a Target card holder, make sure you link Murray! We get a percentage of all purchases. More info. is at <http://www.target.com/tcoe>. There are two payouts per calendar year.

Office Depot's 5% Back to Schools program: This program earns our school free school supplies. Remind the cashiers that you want your purchase to be applied towards Murray. This program is no longer limited to just the back-to-school time in fall, it now runs year-round.
