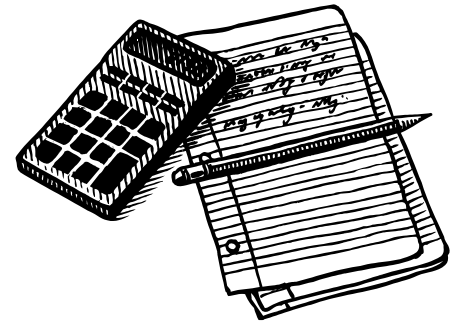
8th Grade Science Students Start Exploring Chemistry in Class
