Mustang families,

On Wednesday, January 13th, the New Hanover County Board of Education voted to keep PK-5 schools in Plan B until at least the end of 3rd quarter. Due to this change, students will remain all remote next week, the 19th-22nd of January. Your child's teacher will reach out to you with the schedule for next week and any needed information regarding schedules.

Plan B will begin on January 25th.

- If you opted for face to face instruction, your child will attend on their scheduled day (A -Monday/Tuesday or B - Thursday/Thursday).
- If you opted for remote only instruction, your child will be expected to participate in Zoom and complete assignments beginning on Monday, January 25th.
- Wednesday will be remote learning for all students. This will remain the same with Morning Mustang Round Up and instructional videos and work that must be completed.

Please see attendance expectations below. Notice the CHANGES for remote learning days.

Remote Learning

Attendance will be taken Monday –Friday based on a students' attendance in synchronous and asynchronous learning. Students not attending Zoom classes and not completing asynchronous assignments will be marked absent.

How can I be counted present?

Synchronous Instruction

- ✓ Participate the entirety of the Zoom lesson
- ✓ Complete the work assigned during the Zoom

Asynchronous Instruction

 Complete the assignment the day it is assigned or by the due date.

Frequently Asked Questions

If I chose face-to-face, can my child work remotely some days?

No. Children enrolled in face-to-face who miss school will be marked absent.

What if my face-to face child is quarantined due to exposure to COVID-19?

Quarantined students who are face-to-face will be assigned work by their teacher to complete at home.

Do I need to send a note if my child is absent?

Yes. All absences, face-to-face or remote, need to be communicated to the teacher. If your child is going to miss instruction, please inform the school.

What percentage of the school day does my child need to attend (remotely or face-to-face) to be counted present?

This policy has not changed. Elementary students need to be present 50% of the day to be counted present. If a partial school day is missed, students must complete missed assignments.
