School Based Counseling and Social Work Services

- •Staffed by NHCS School Counselors and School Social Workers.
- Provides short term counseling for topics such as crisis counseling, communication skills,anger management, organization and study skills grief counseling, and behavior interventions.
- Works with community partners to help families dealing with a crisis, mental health disorders, as well as substance use.
- Provides college and career planning for middle and high school students and career exploration in elementary school.

School Based Therapy Services

- •Staffed by Contracted Professionals (see school list).
- Provides individual and family therapy to students and families.
- •Therapy takes place during the school day without interrupting instruction
- •All school based therapists are licensed.
- High school services are provided through the WHAT Clinics at traditional high schools.

Day Treatment Services @ Lake Forest Academy

- •Staffed by Coastal Horizons, Inc.
- •Grades K-8
- •Enhanced Mental Health Service for students
- •Small teacher:student ratio with counsleors in every classroom

J.C. Roe Center Transition Classroom

- •Staffed by NHCS Teachers and Support Staff
- •For 6-12 students transitioning from residential treatment or long periods of missed school.
- Credit recovery
- Daily small group and skills practice
