If your child will be **3 or 4** years old *on or before* August 31, 2019 you could be eligible for the program!

 - ♦ Goals for Private Speech, Physical, Occupational Therapy, etc.

Bring Your:

- Parent/Guardian Picture I.D.
- Proof of Residency

(Examples: Current property tax statement, Current lease agreement, Current Monthly Mortgage Statement, or NHCS Residency Affidavit (provided by NHCS))

• Income Verification for the year 2018 (Examples: Tax returns, 1099, W2, Dec. 2018 pay stubs, Unemployment Benefits, Letter from Employer with the company letterhead, Social Security Income, Work First/TANF printout, Child Support Payments, Wage Verification Form provided by New Hanover County Schools)

• Legal Guardianship/Custody papers (if applicable)

If you are missing ANY item from the list, the application is INCOMPLETE & we <u>CANNOT</u> ACCEPT it
