Triple P Positive Parenting Stepping Stones Seminars is a series of parenting information presentations for groups of parents who have a child with a developmental disability. They are interactive to allow parents to clearly understand how to implement the principles. Each seminar is a stand-alone session but taken in order the information builds upon the previous training. These are designed to be brief introductions to the principles and how to teach children with disabilities new skills and change problem behaviors. Parents have access to individualized Triple P Stepping Stones training if they want more intensive parenting assistance.
